Safety instructions

To ensure correct installation and use of the lamp and to avoid damage or accidents, the following safety precautions must be followed carefully. Read the instructions carefully before using the product.

General warnings

- 1. Installation:
 - The lamp must be installed and connected by an authorised electrician if required.
 - Always switch off the power at the fuse group before installing, removing or performing maintenance on the lamp.
 - Make sure the lamp is securely fastened and mounted on a suitable surface.

2. Use of the lamp:

- Only use the lamp for its intended purpose and in accordance with the stated specifications (e.g. voltage and bulb type).
- Avoid covering the lamp or placing it close to flammable materials.
- Never use the lamp if it shows signs of damage, such as frayed wires, damaged plugs or cracks in the lampshade.

3. Bulbs and light sources:

- Only use recommended bulbs/light sources as stated in the manual. Never exceed the maximum allowed wattage.
- Allow bulbs to cool completely before replacing them.
- Do not use damaged bulbs.

4. Wetlands and moisture:

- Only use lamps with an appropriate IP rating if the product is to be used in wet rooms, outdoors or other areas with high humidity.
- Make sure that all parts are properly mounted to prevent water ingress.

5. Children and pets:

- Keep the lamp out of reach of small children and pets.
- Make sure there are no loose wires that could pose a tripping hazard.

Electrical warnings

- 1. The lamp must be connected to an earthed socket outlet if required.
- 2. Only use cables and plugs that fulfil applicable safety standards.
- 3. Never attempt to repair damaged electrical parts yourself. Contact a qualified professional.

Maintenance and cleaning

- 1. Switch off the power and disconnect the lamp before cleaning or maintenance.
- 2. Use a dry or slightly damp cloth for cleaning. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasives.
- 3. Regularly check wires and connectors for signs of wear or damage.
